#### **WEDNESDAY JUNE 5 - CHECK-IN DAY**

**WELCOME!** Check in to the INN AT DARDEN. Your registration packet will be at the Front Desk with your reservation at check in. Be sure to **mention that you're with the Airflow Club of America** when you make your reservations. Your rate will be \$119 a night, inclusive of a full, bountiful breakfast. If you haven't already, **make your reservation today** because our block of rooms will be released May 15!



**Want to come early or stay later?** We have blocked some rooms for Airflow members coming in before Wednesday, June 5th. Other rooms are available for Airflow members wishing to lengthen their stay past Sunday June 9th, if you want to linger longer at this lovely spot. Early registration is first come, first served.

**AMPLE Trailer Parking** (*let us know with registration*) and a first rate covered parking garage is available as a guest (please bring a mat/tarp for under your car in case of oil leaks). If shipping your car before the meet, they can be received nearby in Somerset, VA. Arrangements can be made for a local garage if needed, and a flat-bed "Hard Luck Truck". The Inn is 15-20 minutes from Charlottesville Airport (CHO), 60 minutes from Richmond (RIC) and 2 hours from Dulles (IAD) and 10 minutes from an Amtrak Station. The Inn is off of US 250E, near I-64 and US 29.

**Leave the driving to us!** For Airflow convenience, the University operates a Student Bus Service and is at Darden every 30 minutes to go to other parts of the University and great restaurants nearby. The shuttle also connects to a bus trolley that travels to other parts of town. Uber and local cabs are available.

Once you get settled and comfortable at the hotel, find us afterwards in The Airflow Hospitality Room nearby. Come in and say hello and we will answer any last minute questions you may have!

The Inn at Darden is a brick colonial conference hotel to the world famous Darden Business School of Thomas Jefferson's The University of Virginia. It is located at "North Campus" of UVA. The Inn has Sloney's Pub for gathering (5pm-12am) and Saunders Hall where our functions will be held. It has your **FREE bountiful buffet breakfast and a daily coffee service** in an airy sunlit setting. To unwind and work out the kinks from traveling, the University has a world class health and recreation center next door and can be accessed for a nominal fee.

2 pm – The UVA Rotunda Tour – FREE – See registration for sign-up.

Board the UVA bus where we have arranged for a tour of the famous Rotunda Building and Student Housing Pavilion, designed by Thomas Jefferson in the 1830's.

Return to the Inn at Darden, where dinner is on your own at either Sloney's Pub (which serves hors

d'oeuvres) or at the numerous restaurants available a short hop away in Charlottesville. The town has a great student vibe and is a safe locale. We will have a recommended list of restaurants with varied menus! Remember to tuck in your Airflows for the night and get your sleep, as Thursday is a Big Day!

### **THURSDAY, JUNE 6 - James Madison's Montpelier Day**

9 am — Depart from the Inn at Darden for an Airflow-friendly, scenic drive to James Madison's Montpelier (50 miles round trip). Dating back to the 1700's, this is the home of The Father of the Constitution. Montpelier has been restored to its former glory and has a first-rate theater and memento shop. Our guided tour will include some great stories. To read up on this remarkable President try The Three Lives of James Madison by Noah Feldman.



**LUNCH** From Montpelier, we caravan "next door" to your Airflow Hosts', Darby and Monte Gingery's farm, **Somerset Plantation** to enjoy a tented, scenic Blue-Ridge-Mountain-View luncheon. A local historian will give a talk on the rich local history. Somerset was constructed in 1803 by Madison's sister, Sally, and her husband. After lunch and a garden stroll, we depart southward on VA Route 20 to **Barboursville Vineyards**, the first commercial winery in modern times to help spawn a thriving winery culture in Virginia. They offer Wine Tastings and beautiful views. In addition, we also have Muscle Car Paradise next door.
