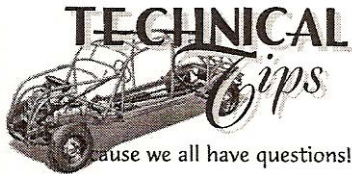

Adjusting Door Strikers

Door strikers at the top and bottom of the doors are provided to aid in preventing door rattles and to hold the doors in alignment. They also compensate for slight misalignment caused by improperly adjusted hinges, or worn hinge pins.

When a door is closed, the strikers (*wedge shaped plates*) at the top and bottom of the door should both contact their mating surfaces in the body. This can be tested by holding strip of tough paper against the contact surfaces of the plates in the body, and closing the door. If the paper cannot be pulled out without tearing, the strikers are properly adjusted.
