



Gas Gauge Sending Unit Source

I got to the wiring part of my Airflow restoration and had a gas gauge that read empty. I checked the sending unit and discovered that it was not sending. I took the gauge to *United Speedometer* here in Riverside and they had a replacement.

They didn't like the Stewart-Warner units, so they recommended the VDO 226 008D adjustable fuel sender 0-90 ohm. To make the gauge work in the Airflow, just reverse the float to the opposite side recommended and it reads 90-0 ohms. I installed it and it works! The mounting holes are right too. I reset the mounting plate so that the float faces the rear of the tank, free from internal obstructions. The price of the part was \$44.00.
