

Editor's Note. - Jim's letter brought to mind probably a lesser known part of the P.O.'s ZIP Code Rules, it is not necessary to include postal zone numbers when the address contains a ZIP Code number. I find that there is very little different between models and years of the Airflows with respect to fenderskirts. The outline of them seems to be the same size and shape (full semicircle). Pictures are generally front views and chromework is not very identifiable. The Chrysler cars seemed to have their fender skirt chrome come in a manner characterized by the shown in Sketch "A" below. DeSotos showed chrome on their fenderskirts similar to that shown in Sketch "B". below. I have yet to see a photo (submitted by a member) which shows a DeSoto with skirts with chrome like

that shown in Sketch "C". That sounds funny, know, but a Chrysler Corp pic, sent me for CAR LIFE (page 72) shows one like it. One of several SAT. EVE. POST ads I have also show this design. Probably pre-production pictures. Oh, well, it appears that there are two basic designs, anyway.
