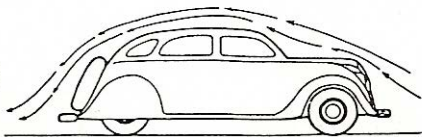

## Bearing For Intermediate Steering Gear on C-10 by O.P. Higbee

In June 1990, before leaving for the ACA National at St. Louis, I checked the steering on my C-10 and found both tie rod ends had some play as well as the intermediate steering lever. After replacing the tie rod ends and having the toe-in set, it was time to remove the intermediate lever. Most Airflow owners are probably only vaguely aware of this part. I discovered the bearing that I took out was a Torrington #BH 1624. It is still available at the cost of \$3.62. The original Chrysler part number is 658868. This bearing will fit the 1936 C-9; C-10; C-11. I cannot be certain if the bearing fits other models or years.
