Dear Jim & Paula,

I just discovered something that is a very good substitute for the '36 Chrysler parking light lens. It's the lens from a universal type snap in license light used in the rear bumpers of many pickup trucks. The NAPA number is 81-3505. To remove the lens from this unit, cut the chrome ring that acts as a partial shield for the lens. The light is pressed together and must be separated with pliers or sidecutters to get to the lens, which, when mounted in the horn grille, covers very close to the original in appearance.
