To redo the metal plates on the floor under the doors first clean the plate as good as possible then paint the entire exposed area with paint. Sand off the excess paint carefully. This will leave the lettering and design looking like new in the grooves.--Ed Snell

When rewiring your Airflows' head lights and tail lights it is just as important that the lights have a good ground as the connections coming to the light bulbs be good. The car body is the "other wire" coming back to the battery. It may even be necessary to solder a wire directly on the side of the light bulb to get a good ground and get the "Red Out" of the lights so the bulb will burn white. Be sure to use large enough wires, not 12 volt wiring.--O. P. Higbee

Do not try to pull windshield gasket into groove. Stretch it into the groove with your hands; pliers will tear it. Same rubber for 1936 Ford closed cars will fit.--Herman Spacek
